






CONNECTION

FAST INSTALLATION

Connect the receiver and other equipments according to "CONNECTION".

- Connect this unit to a mains outlet, then press STANDBY button to turn on the unit.
- 2. Press MENU button to access the menu system, then press ▲/▼ button to choose Tools submenu, then press ▶ button to access it with the default password "0000" input. Use CH-/CH+ button to choose Factory Setting, press ▶ again to access before pushing ∢/▶ button to choose YES and press OK to confirm the restoration of Factory Setting. Once the operation is finished, press EXIT to quit.

Note: It is a must to perform this operation if this receiver is used for the first time or the software has just been upgraded.

- 3. Press ▲/▼ button to move to Installation submenu, then press ▶ button to access it with the password "0000" input.
 - a. Press > button to highlight Satellite List where a satellite should be selected, and press EXIT to quit once the selection is complete. (Please conduct this operation following the guidance displayed on the screen);
 - b. Press > button to access LNB Freq where the Local Oscillation Frequency of the tuner and some other related items can be set after you choose Antenna Setup. Press EXIT to quit as soon as the setup is finished.
 - c. Press > button to highlight Single/ Multi Satellite to set the search information involved, then press > button again to start Auto Search.

Regarding actual operation please refer to the following instructions for more information.

Press A/V button to move the cursor up and down to select one item, and press or **OK** button to enter the submenu; 4/EXIT/MENU button are used to get back to the upper-level menu, and EXIT/MENU to quit menu operation.

Note: 1. A, Y, P, 4, PG+, PG-, OK, EXIT and MENU buttons function the same in menus at all levels; PG+/ PG- button can be used not only to turn over gages, but also to select a satellite.

- 2. Refer to the screen hints during operation of some menu items.
- The color buttons represent different function in different menu windows.

Shortcut Keys

- 2. TEXT: View the text information of the current service (if available).
- 3. Subtitle: Enable or disable subtitle display on the screen (if available).

I Edit Channel

Press OK to enter the submenu which includes 3 items.

I.1 Channel Edit

Press **OK** to enter this item, and use ▲/▼ to select the channel to Edit. In the right side of the menu, it have 4 icons. Press > button, you can select Move/Lock/Delete/Edit/Skip icon.

- Move: Select channels you want to move. Press ▶ button to select icon, Press **OK** button, then move the channel by using ▲/▼ button.
- Lock: Select channels you want to lock. Press → button to select icon. Press OK button, then the channel will be locked. Press MENU/EXIT button and Press Yes button to save.
- icon. Press OK button, then the channel will be deleted. Press MENU/EXIT button and Press Yes button to confirm.
- · Remame: Select one channel you want to rename. Press > button to select (icon. Press OK button, then it will display a window to modify the name of the channel.

Red button (CAPS): Use this button to shift the alphabet form (capitalized/ small).

Green button(DEL): Delete present letter.

Yellow(OK) button: Confirm current editing status. Blue(CANCEL): Cancel editing operation and exit.

• Skip: Select channels you want to skip. Press > button to select 🔁 icon. Press **OK** button, the channels will be skipped .

RED(Group): Select the channels by groups. (ALL/Favorite/Satellite/Provide/A~Z).

GREEN(Option): Select the channels by Option. (Select All/Unselect All/ Select Others/Select TP/Select Satellite/Lock/Skip)









I.2 Favourites Edit

Press **OK** button to enter this submenu.

- Add: Select channels you want to add to Favorite Group, then press
 ▶ button to select + icon. Press
 MENU/EXIT to save the operation.
- Delete: Select channels you want to delete from Favorite Group, then press \(^\) button to select \(^\) icon. Press \(^\) MENU/EXIT to save the operation.
- Rename: Select channels then press
 d or ▶ button to select
 icon, then it will display a window to modify the name of Favorite Group.

Press **OK** button to enter the submenu item, there are four item to setup.

- Local Longitude: Input the number of longitude.

- LNB Power: Two selection On/Off.
- Limit Setup: Press **OK** button, it will display three selections
 (Disable Limit/East Limit/West Limit).



II.2 Satellite List

Press **OK** button to enter the submenu item, and press **A/** button to select a satellite, or press **EXIT/ MENU** to quit current operation.

● Edit: Press **Red** button to edit the satellite. Use ▲/▼ button to select the items, there are Name/Longitude/LNB Freq/DiSEqC1.0/DiSEqC1.1./

22K/Motor Type to edit.
Red button(CAPS): Use this button to shift the alphabet form;
Green button(DEL): Delete present letter;

Yellow(OK) button: Confirm current editing status;

Blue(CANCEL): Cancel editing operation and exit.

• Add: Press **Green** button to add a satellite. Regarding the operation, refer

to the Edit section above.


Delete: Use ▲/▼ to choose the satellites you want to delete, and press blue button to delete a Satellite by selecting Yes or No in the screen hints.

- DiSEqC1.0 : Press **OK** to select a port..
- 22K: Use ◀/▶ button to activate 22K Hz switch, select On/Off.
- Motor Type: Use ◀ / ➤ button to select a item(Off/DiSEqC1.2/USALS).

II.4 Single Satellite Search

- Satellite: Press **OK** to choose a satellite for search.
- FTA Only: Select Yes /No.
- Scan Channel: TV Channel, Radio, and TV + Radio.
- Network Search: Yes\No.
 (This operation can be performed only in Preset Scan mode.)
- Scan Mode: Blind Scan/Preset Scan/Accurate Scan.
- Search: Start searching.

II.5 Multi Satellite Search

- Satellite: Press **OK** to choose a satellite for search.
- FTA Only: Select Yes /No.
- Scan Channel: TV Channel, Radio, and TV + Radio.
- Network Search: Yes\No. (This operation can be performed only in Preset Scan mode.)

II.6 TP List (Transponder List)



After setup, Press Apply button to active the network.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

In case of trouble, please refer following table to solve problems.

SYMPTOMS	CHECK POINTS
Power is not "ON"	Check the power cord.
No Sound	Check the audio jack. Check whether the Mute function is on or not.
No Satellite TV Channel	Check the direction of antenna. Check the connection of antenna cable. Check whether the channel search process has been done correctly.
Poor Video & Audio quality	Check whether the signal level is proper or not. Check whether there is damage on the antenna or not. Adjust the height and direction of antenna.
Remote Control is not working	Check whether the batteries are properly fitted into battery rack of your remote control or not. Make sure the remote sensor is not broken.
